#### **WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981**

## SUFFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (PARISH OF MILDENHALL) MODIFICATION ORDER 2025

Public footpaths, bridleways, restricted byways and byways open to all traffic are recorded on definitive maps and statements. These maps and statements provide conclusive legal evidence of the existence of public rights. Suffolk County Council is responsible for the definitive map and statement and has a duty to amend them when <a href="evidence">evidence</a> suggests that they are inaccurate or incomplete. Such amendments are made by means of modification orders under section 53 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981. These orders do not come into effect until confirmed, and if there are any objections the County Council must refer the order and objections to the Department of Environment, Food and Rural Affairs in Bristol.

The County Council has made a modification order under Section 53 to add a restricted byway as detailed in the order. This order simply recognises the public rights that the authority believes exist. The order does not create any new public rights.

The right of objection to an order is a statutory right, but it should be exercised in a reasonable manner. The costs involved in dealing with objections to orders are normally awarded against objectors only in cases of unreasonable behaviour.

If there are no objections to the order, or if all objections are withdrawn, the County Council will confirm the order, and the definitive map and statement will then be modified. If there are any objections which are not withdrawn, the County Council must refer the order and objections to the Department of Environment, Food and Rural Affairs, who will appoint an independent Inspector to consider the order and hear the objections, normally by holding a public inquiry. The Inspector may confirm the order, with or without modifications, or may decide that the order should not be confirmed.

#### Part 1: Modification of Definitive Map

Description of restricted byway to be added:

There shall be added to the Definitive Map for the parish of Mildenhall a restricted byway from a point at Ordnance Survey grid reference 56739,27577 (point A) to a point at Ordnance Survey grid reference 56724,27579 (point B) as shown on the attached map.

There shall be added to the Definitive Statement for Mildenhall the following particulars:


#### Mildenhall Restricted Byway 64

Commencing at a junction with the C603 road (Friday Street) at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) 56739,27577 (point A) and progressing in a generally westerly direction along a track for approximately 152 metres and terminating at a gap between a hedge and a chain link fence at OSGR 56724,27579 (point B) at the edge of the West Row village hall carpark.

Width: 2.4 metres

Limitation: Gap approximately 1.0 metre wide between a hedge and a chain link fence at OSGR 56724,27579 (point B).

(The path width is based on an average of all widths specified in the user evidence forms).
