

## NOTES

- 1. Tactile slabs to be laid parallel to the crossing studs which may not necessarily be square to the crossing.
- Tactile slabs to be coloured red at signal controlled crossings. In Conservation Areas, road studs or buff/grey tactiles paving can be used.
- Inspection chamber and manhole covers within area of tactile paving to be fitted with recessed covers inlaid with tactile paving.
- 4. Refer to other standard drawing for traffic signal pole NAL socket details and exact position of traffic signal poles to be agreed with SCC.
- 5. Tactile slabs to have no less than  $\frac{1}{3}$  cuts.
- 6. Advice on the layout of crossings can be found in the Department For Transports document "Inclusive Mobility".
- 7. Road markings and signing to be in accordance with the current Traffic Sign Regulations.
- 8. Pedestrian crossing studs to be used on SCC traffic controlled crossing. Road markings to diagram no. 1055 are not acceptable.
