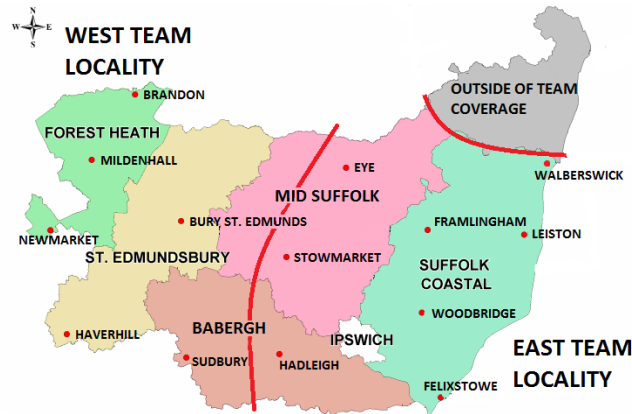

Eligibility Criteria:

The Team supports children diagnosed with a Significant Learning Disability (moderate to severe) who also have behaviour support needs up to the age of 18 years old. For some referrals this support may be limited until the extent of disability is fully known. For those children who do not meet our criteria to receive a service, the Parent/Carer will be informed and signposted to an appropriate service.

What Do We Offer?

We offer a specialist service to families, carers and professionals which incorporates a holistic approach to meet the behavioural needs of children and young people with learning disabilities in the community.

We aim to help the individual by providing specific, time-limited behaviour support interventions based on assessed need. The work will be completed through the use of visits to the home/school/wider community, short break services, group work or clinic based appointments.

The types of behaviour that the team can assist with may include:

- Challenging behaviour
- General behaviour management
- Anger/Aggression
- Anxiety
- Sleep
- Meal Time management
- Daily living
- Social Skills
- Communication
- Play Skills
- Cooperating with routine
- Adolescence/Puberty
- Sexuality
- Menstruation
- Self-Esteem
- Mental Health
- Continence Management and Promotion (e.g. Toilet Training)
